Camden is a family owned business formed by Patrick Lavery in 1983, and are marking their 40th year in business in 2024. The business is now led by Patrick's son, Brian Lavery, who is the current CEO. Camden has been an innovator and market leader in PVCu products for over 39 years, allowing them to produce their very own profile system consisting of 80% recycled content. Recently, Camden have committed to being net zero by 2040.

#### CAMDEN'S SUSTAINABLE INITIATIVES AND USE OF SUSTAINIQ

To achieve this they have implemented a closed-loop manufacturing process whereby they recycle and reprocess materials back into the production line. In order to increase their transparency in ESG initiatives, they are implementing SustainIQ across the business to track and report on their progress. This will ensure complete visibility of their carbon footprint and allow strategic reporting of carbon data.

<u>SustainIQ</u> is the all-in-one ESG & sustainability reporting software that measures, monitors and reports on the social, economic, and environmental performance of businesses.

#### Challenges Camden were having with ESG reporting
